Claysburg-Kimmel had two teams compete in the Blair County Envirothon on April 25th. The competition tested student knowledge in Forestry, Wildlife, Aquatics, and Soils. The CK teams finished in 5th and 7th place out of 14 teams that competed.

The 9th grade Environmental Science classes and Envirothon club attended the Outdoor Exposition at Mount Aloysius April 4th. It was a career fair around the "outdoor" cluster of job titles. The careers spanned the range of Government agency jobs to very localized environmental companies in conservation and recreation. The students listened to various speakers that talked about careers in the environmental field (Pa Fish and Boat Commission, Prince Gallitzin State Park, Golden Acres Farm, etc.). Students were also given an opportunity to fish in the nearby pond and climb an inflatable rock wall for fun.
