Dear Parents and Guardians,

This afternoon Governor Tom Wolf announced that all K-12 Pennsylvania schools will be closed for 10 business days effective Monday, March 16. The administration has been working with school districts as well as state and local officials to gather input on this decision. The Wolf Administration will continue to monitor Covid-19 in the commonwealth, and at the end of 10 days will reevaluate and decide whether continued closure is needed.

Based upon the information we have at this time:

**All schools in the Claysburg Kimmel School District will be closed beginning Monday, March 16 through Friday, March 27, 2020.**

**We will be instituting our flexible instruction day (FID) plan starting Monday March 16.**

**Technical help is available at 814-239-0356 and assignment help is available by contacting your teacher via email or calling the building office.**

We understand this decision may cause hardship for some of our families; however, the decision was made as a proactive measure to ensure the health, safety, and well-being of our students, families, staff and community.

During this time, all school building activities, including child care, preschool, athletics, extracurricular activities, health services, and all other events are suspended.
