LEXIA: Reading App

LEXIA: IMPROVE READING SKILLS AT HOME

READING. CKE students are using the Lexia Core5 (Grades K – 5) and Lexia Power Up (Grade 6) apps on at school. Each student moves at his or her own pace and can progress independently to higher levels. If the student struggles in a particular activity, Core5 will automatically adjust and provide activities that give explicit instruction to strengthen the deficiency. If the student continues to struggle within the explicit instruction, the teacher is notified and provided with the data and resources for direct instruction on that particular skill.



HOW TO ACCESS LEXIA USING A TABLET/SMART PHONE

STEP 1: Get the Apps.

The apps are free to download and CKSD has already purchased your child's licenses. You can download the apps the same way you download any other app. NOTE: You will need to download the Clever app  to access the Lexia app.

STEP 2: Use the Apps.

LEXIA: Open the Clever app and enter the login information. Your child should already know how to login. In case you should need to know, the username is your child's 6-digit lunch number (example: 123456) and the password is also your child's 6-digit lunch number (example 123456).

IXL: IMPROVE MATH SKILLS AT HOME

MATH. The IXL Math app allows each student to move at his or her own pace and can progress independently to higher levels. If the student struggles in a particular concept (Numbers & Operations, Algebra & Algebraic Thinking, Fractions, Geometry, Measurement, and Date, Statistics, & Probability), IXL will prompt students with activities to strengthen the weaknesses.

HOW TO ACCESS IXL USING A TABLET

STEP 1: Get the Apps.

DIRECTIONS TO ACCESS AR QUIZZES (which students should already know):

User name is USUALLY The first letter of the student's first name followed by the first four letters of his/her last name.

Example: George Washington - gwash

Password: elem (case sensitive) – this password applies to every student

Some students may have a number after the letter because of multiple students with similar names.

Example: George Washington – gwash

Geoff Washington – gwash1
